Lifeguard Training (15+years old)

Course candidates will become lifeguards by gaining the necessary skills needed to recognize, prevent and respond to aquatic emergencies. Prerequisites are: Swim 300 meters combination of front crawl and breaststroke (non-stop swimming), tread water for 2 minutes (non-stop) without use of hands or arms, perform a surface dive 9 feet to retrieve a 10 pound brick and swim back holding the brick on top of the water (timed)

Participants must have a passing score of 80% or better on all exams and pass the final skills scenario to receive certifications. The course certifications include Lifeguarding/First Aid/CPR/AED for Professional Rescuer (valid 2 years). Must attend every class – NO EXCEPTIONS!
